## Why vote?

Every Canadian citizen has the right to vote; it is how Canadians choose which leaders represent them. Voting is a responsibility that all Canadians should exercise because voting connects citizens with the political process and with each other. Most importantly, your community is shaped by the outcome of an election. When you take part in an election and express your view, you make democracy work.

## What is the vote for?

### City of Calgary Mayor and Councillors

### Calgary Public and Separate School Trustees

In 2021, you will receive ballots for Mayor, Councillor, and School Board Trustee (either Public or Separate). This is determined by the School District which you support. You will also be asked to vote on reintroducing fluoride, nominees for the Senate of Canada and referendum questions.

## Personal information

Personal information is collected under the authority of Section 33 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, and is used for purposes of conducting the election. For additional information, please contact the Deputy City Clerk, Elections Calgary at 2340 22nd St. N.E., Calgary, AB and at 403-476-4100.

### What is my Voter Statement?

Before you vote you must sign a statement\* stating you are eligible to vote. Check your voter eligibility below.

*\* It is an offense under Section 148(4) of the Local Authorities Election Act to make or sign a false statement, punishable by imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or a fine of not more than \$10,000, or both a fine and imprisonment.*

## Who can vote?

You are eligible to vote in this General Election if on Election Day you:

- Are at least 18 years old.
- Are a Canadian citizen.
- Are a resident on Election Day;
  - of the city of Calgary, to vote for Mayor; and
  - of the ward, to vote for Councillor; and
  - of the Calgary Board of Education, for Public School Trustee; or
  - of the Calgary Roman Catholic Separate School Division, for Separate School Trustee.
- Provide one of the authorized pieces of identification.



# Voting information

## Where do I vote?

During the Advance Vote and on Election Day you must vote at your designated voting station.

### Find it online

Visit [electionscalgary.ca](https://electionscalgary.ca) and use the Where Do I Vote? tool. Search using your residential home address to check what ward you are in and find your Voting Station location. Then visit the Calgary Library's website at [planmyvote.ca](https://planmyvote.ca) to make your personalized vote plan.

### Find it in this Guide

Some ward boundaries are changing on Election Day. Confirm your new ward online, turn to the appropriate page for your ward and, using the ward map, determine the number of the voting subdivision where you reside. There is a list of voting station names and addresses in this Guide.

**Note:** If a voting subdivision boundary is a street, the centre of the street is the dividing line.

## Special voting options

### You may request a special (mail-in) ballot if:

You are unable to vote during the Advance Vote or on Election Day because:

- a. of physical disability or illness; or
- b. you are absent from the city; or
- c. you are working Election Day as an election worker, candidate, agent, scrutineer or campaign worker.

### Applications for the special (mail-in) ballots can be made:

- By filling out a request on The City website – [electionscalgary.ca](https://electionscalgary.ca); or
- By phoning the Elections Office: 403-476-4100; or
- In person at the Elections Office, 2340 22nd St. N.E., Calgary, Alberta; or
- In writing to Elections Calgary, #207 PO Box 2100 Station M Calgary, AB T2P 2M5.

The deadline for requesting a mail-in ballot is noon on October 18, 2021, Election Day. Completed ballots must be received by the Elections Calgary office (Elections Calgary, #207 PO Box 2100 Station M Calgary, AB T2P 2M5) by 4:00 pm on Election Day. You must include a photocopy of one of the authorized pieces of ID (see page 10) and submit the ballots and ID in the provided envelopes. Instructions on completing your mail-in ballot package are included in the package.

Ballots can also be returned to one of our six drop-box locations:

- Fish Creek Library
- Seton Library
- Elections Calgary Office
- City Hall Building (24 hour drop box)

Drop-boxes are secure and monitored by CCTV.

### What if I need help voting?

Voters with disabilities can vote using the following methods:

- Request a mail-in ballot.
- Use the accessible voting machine at any Advance Vote location. Accessible voting machines are not available on Election Day.
  - Voters can mark a ballot using: braille keypad, touch-screen ballot (text size and contrast can be adjusted), puff and sip, audio recording of ballot (headset used), or paddle.
- Magnifying glasses are available in voting stations upon request.
- Have a family member/friend, or an election worker assist in marking your ballot (note: anyone assisting will be required to sign a statement; therefore, they must be 18 years of age or older).
- A curbside vote can be requested if you have a disability that prevents you from entering the building or if you are unable to wear a mask (e.g. medical condition or other legal exemption). Please bring someone who can alert an election worker to this request. As this is a supplementary service, longer wait times may occur or you may wish to consider a mail-in ballot.
- Language translation will also be available at many locations.

### Can I vote if I am in the hospital?

# Voting information

## Voter identification

Voters must present one of the following forms of identification (ID) showing their name and current residential address before being allowed to vote. **Picture ID is not required to vote.**

### ID issued by any level of Canadian government

(or an agency of that government) with a photograph of the elector and their name and current address

- Alberta Operator's (Driver's) Licence.
- Alberta Identification Card.

### Government-issue documents

- Government cheque or cheque stub.
- Income/property tax assessment notice.
- Statement of government benefits (e.g. employment insurance, old-age security, social assistance, disability support or child tax benefit).

### School, college, or university documents

- Correspondence issued by a school, college or university.

### Attestation

- Attestation of Identity and Residence issued by the authorized representative of a facility that provides services to the homeless.
- Attestation of Identity and Residence issued by the authorized representative of a correctional institution.
- Attestation of Identity and Residence issued by the responsible authority of a supportive living facility or treatment centre.
- Attestation of Residence issued by the authorized representative (landlord) of a commercial property management company.
- Attestation of Residence issued by the authorized representative of a post-secondary institution.

### Other documents

- Bank/credit card statement or personal cheque.
- Insurance policy or coverage card.
- Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee.
- Pension Plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation.

- Residential lease or mortgage statement.
- Utility bill (e.g. telephone, public utilities commission, television, electric, gas or water).
- Vehicle ownership, registration or insurance certificate.

Voters must produce one of the required forms of ID and sign the statement to receive their ballots and cast their vote.

## Vouching

A person (e.g. a roommate, neighbor or family member) may vouch for and validate another voter's identity and address if the person vouching is voting at the same designated voting station, and can provide one of the acceptable forms of ID. The person vouching may only do this for one household (maximum) and may not do so if they were vouched for themselves.



## Voter Checklist

## COVID-19 safety protocols

We will be following all public health orders as set out by The Province of Alberta and bylaws as set out by The City of Calgary to make this a safe voting experience. COVID-19 safety protocols will be in place as required to help reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission among workers, volunteers, candidates and voters.

### What Elections Calgary plans to do

- Staff will wear face mask or coverings.

- Furniture and signage will be in place to allow for distancing.
- Barriers may be used in voting stations.

### What you can do

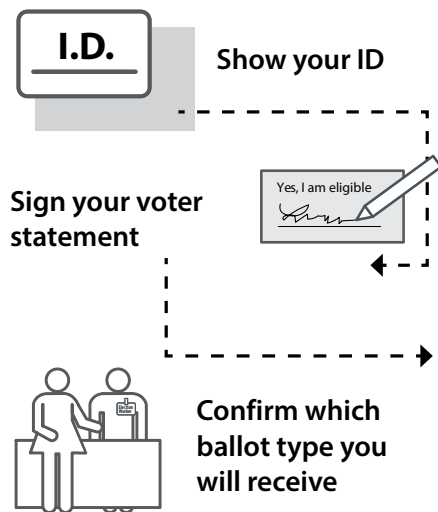
- Face masks or coverings will be required, subject to legal exceptions.

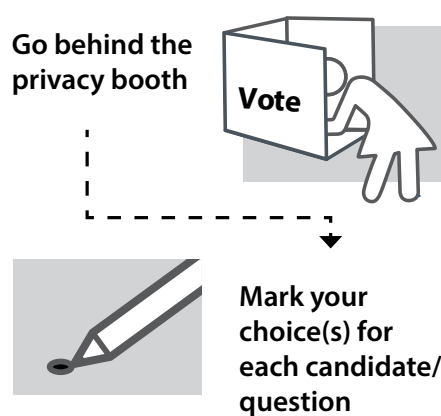

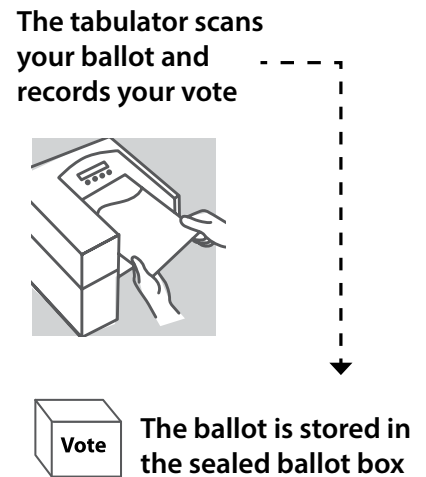

## What is on the ballot?

This year you will receive two ballots – a municipal and a provincial ballot.

- Voters will elect **City Council and school board trustees**.
- Voters will vote on **reintroducing fluoride to our water**.
- Voters will select **nominees for the Senate of Canada**.
- Voters will vote on **referendums about equalization payments and Daylight-Saving Time**.

### Senate election and referendum questions

Voters will select up to 3 nominees for the Senate of Canada. Nominees may be appointed when vacancies occur.

Voters will vote on two referendum questions:

**Question 1: Should section 36(2) of the Constitution Act, 1982, Parliament and the government of Canada's commitment to the principle of making equalization payments, be removed from the Constitution?**

Your answer choices: **yes or no**

**Question 2: Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight-Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?**

Your answer choices: **yes or no**

## Water fluoridation

Voters will vote on reintroducing fluoride to Calgary's water.

### Question: Are you in favour of reintroducing fluoridation of the municipal water supply?

Your answer choices: **yes or no.**

The fluoride vote is not binding on Council. City Council makes the final decision.

## Fluoride in Calgary's water

### What is fluoride?

Fluorides are chemical compounds naturally found in air, water, soil and almost all foods. Fluorides are commonly released into the environment by erosion resulting in natural concentrations in surface and ground waters.

### Does fluoride occur naturally in our drinking water?

Fluoride naturally occurs in the Bow and Elbow Rivers, in concentrations varying throughout the year, between 0.1 and 0.4 mg/L.

### What are Health Canada's guidelines regarding fluoride?

Health Canada's guidelines for Canadian Drinking Water Quality continue to recommend optimal fluoride dosing to be 0.7 mg/L and has set a maximum allowable concentration of 1.5 mg/L.

### What is Calgary's fluoridation history?

#### 1957-1971

- Calgarians vote against adding fluoride to its drinking water four times in 1957, 1961, 1966 and 1971.

#### 1989-1991

- In a 1989 plebiscite, Calgarians voted in favour of adding fluoride to the city's drinking water. By 1991, fluoride was being added to Calgary's drinking water at a target of 1.0 mg/L.

#### 1998-1999

- In 1998, The City and Alberta Health Services reviewed water fluoridation as a public policy, and a panel of five experts recommended a reduction in the level of fluoride to 0.7 mg/L. This change was adopted in 1999

following a second plebiscite where Calgarians again voted in favour of fluoridation by 55 per cent.

#### 2011-Present

- The City of Calgary discontinued the addition of fluoride to Calgary's drinking water as directed by Council on May 19, 2011.

### What would the cost of adding fluoride to Calgary's water be?

Estimated costs to reintroduce fluoridation:

- Capital costs for infrastructure at the two water treatment plants – \$10.1 million
- Annual operating costs - \$864,000 per year
- Annual maintenance costs - \$100,000 to \$200,000 per year
- Approximately \$30.1 million over a 20-year life span

### Can these costs be absorbed in the current Water Utility budget?

Current operating and capital budgets do not include the costs associated with reintroducing fluoridation. Should Council decide to add fluoride to Calgary's drinking water a budget request will be prepared. Reintroduction of fluoridation is not expected to increase water rates.

### Why can't the infrastructure from 2011 be used?

Existing infrastructure, which had reached the end of its life cycle in 2011, was decommissioned and removed following the Council decision to stop fluoridation.

### How long will it take to implement fluoridation?

The current timeline is 18-24 months once a decision to reinstate fluoride has been made.

### Which municipalities in Alberta add fluoride to their drinking water? Which do not?

Do: Lethbridge, Red Deer and Edmonton

Do not: Banff, Canmore, Medicine Hat, Okotoks (stopped in 2012), Cochrane, High River.

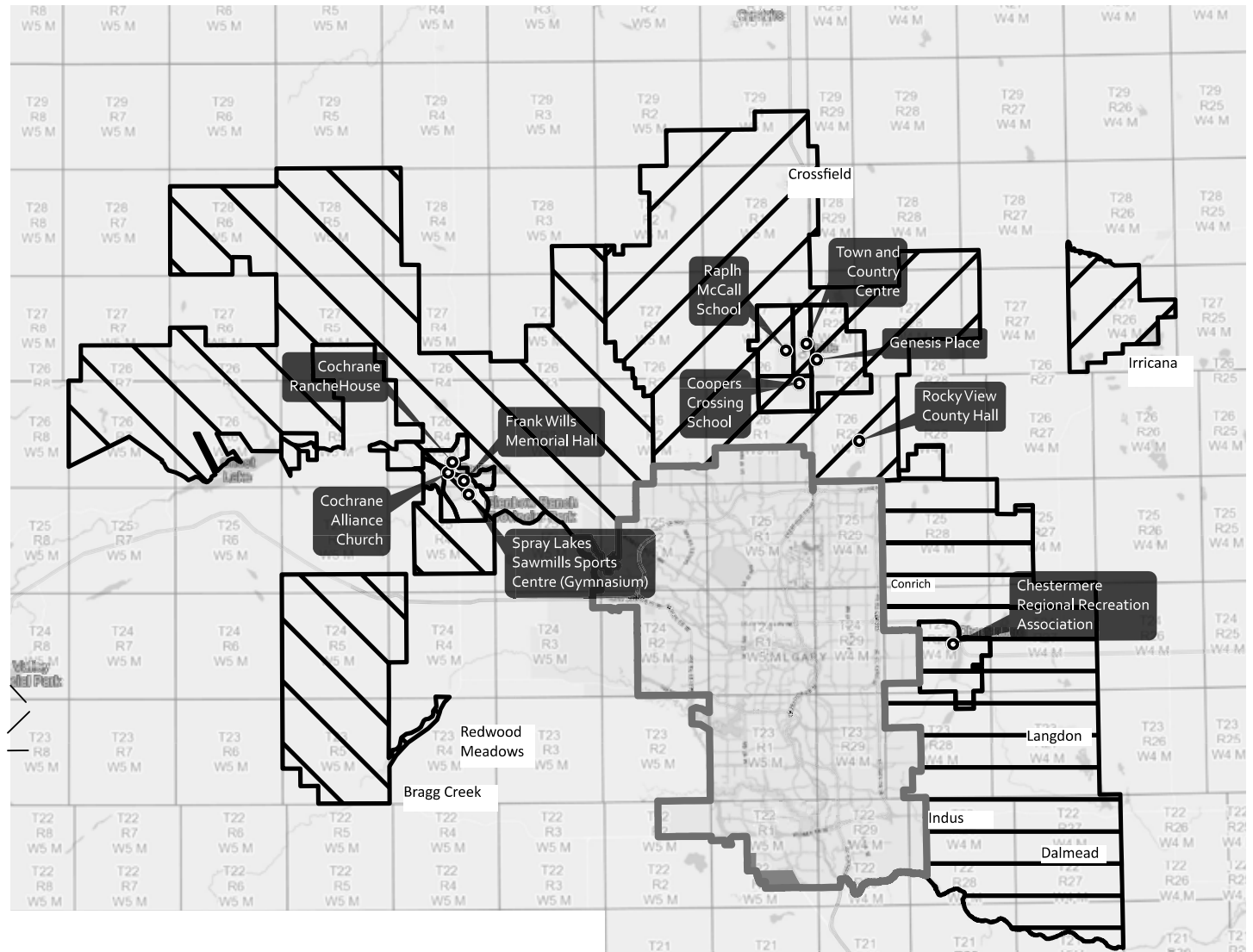

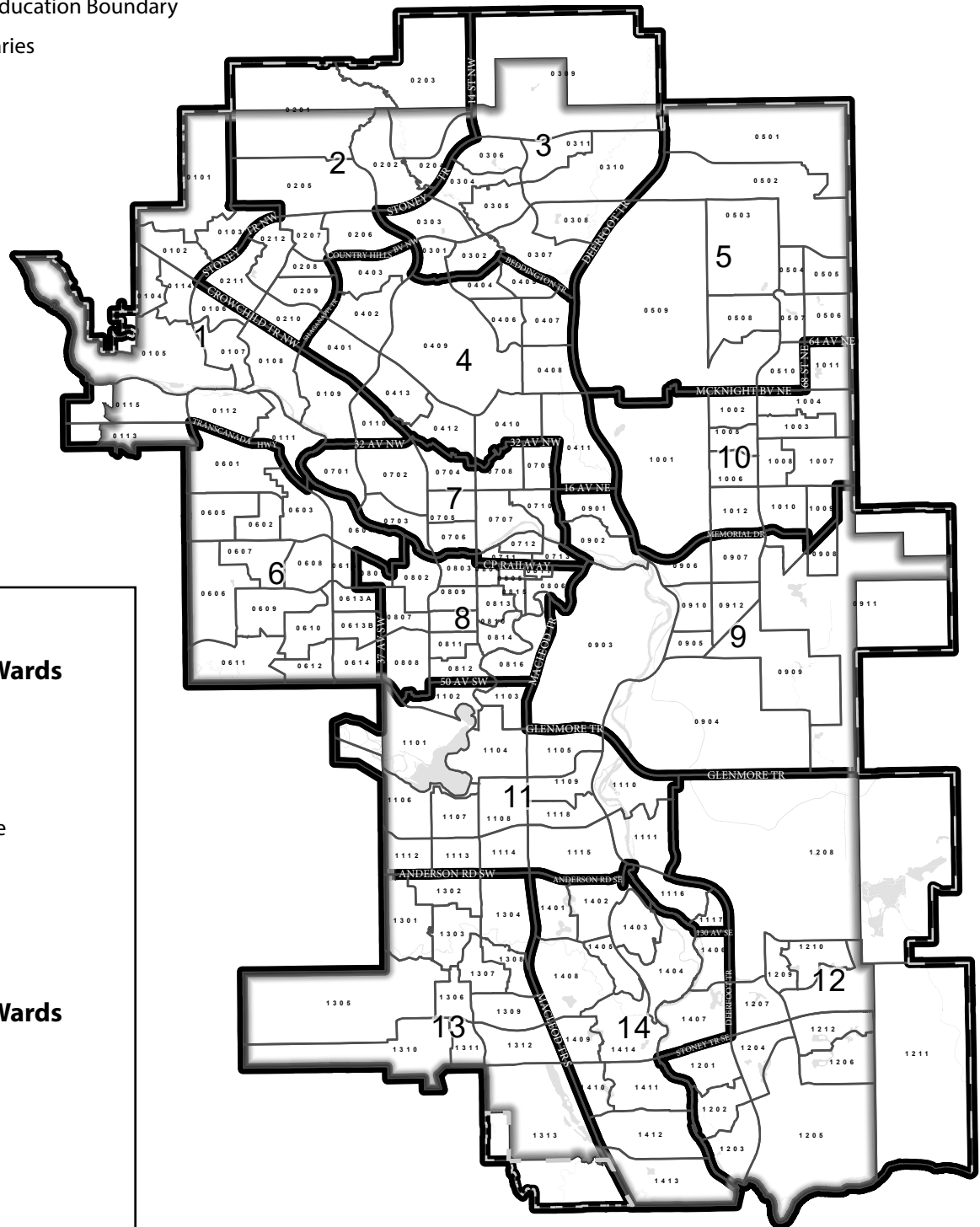
