## Project Update - February 2020

The City of Calgary continues to work along the west side of the Bow River bank, building a new Bonnybrook outfall and emergency bypass channel. This infrastructure is an integral part of the flood protection plan for the Bonnybrook WWTP.

Heavy construction, including the installation of underground utilities, will continue through to the fall of 2020, with some remaining landscaping work extending into 2021. The work will be carried out by KLS Earthworks and Environmental.

Any construction required in and around the Bow River is being timed to adhere to the Alberta Government's Restricted Activity Period, to ensure fish, their eggs and juveniles are protected from harm, including monitoring and controls to limit the introduction of sediment to the river.

During spring and summer of 2020, the installation of utilities requires geotechnical investigation adjacent to Deerfoot Trail, on the west embankment of the Calf Robe Bridge. The information gathered from this investigation will be used to plan and execute a utility crossing under the bridge, to ensure the work can be conducted safely, with no interruption to the roadway.
