

Bonnybrook Plant Expansion Update

Spring 2022

Background

The Bonnybrook Wastewater Treatment Plant is the largest of Calgary's three wastewater treatment plants, with a capacity to treat the wastewater from approximately one million people.

Due to continued population growth, expansion of the existing Bonnybrook Wastewater Treatment Plant is required to increase the available treatment capacity. Enhancements to the plant will improve long-term environmental performance to continue to protect the Bow River for future generations. The Bonnybrook Plant Expansion and Upgrades project began in 2014 and is anticipated to be completed in 2025.

Construction updates


- The remaining section of Bow River Pathway from the Bonnybrook Bridge to the intersection of Ogden Road SE and 42 Av SE will be constructed this spring.
- As a result, we need to temporarily close the section of the pathway which connects to the Bonnybrook Bridge.
- The closure is planned for June 4 July 11.
- A pathway detour will be set up adjacent to Ogden Road for bike and pedestrian traffic.

Construction impacts

- For safety purposes, work sites will be fenced and access will be restricted to construction personnel only
- A pathway detour will be set up adjacent to Ogden Road for bike and pedestrian traffic. See attached map.
- A temporary pathway is paved along the East side of Ogden Road.
- One southbound lane of Ogden Road will be converted to an adaptive roadway with solid barriers in place to provide cover for individuals using the roadway.
- The pathway detour will impact traffic on southbound Ogden Road SE.
- Bus stop #4534 on southbound Routes 24 and 147, will be temporarily relocated while the pathway detour is in place.
