

# Transit Safety in Canada<sup>1</sup>


Across Canada, there has been a significant increase in transit violence over the past year.



Although the majority of Canadians report feeling safe when using public transit, more Canadians say they feel safer riding with friends or family than when they do so alone.




#### Low Income Transit Pass



Many Canadians have felt the impact of inflation. The City's Low Income Transit Pass is an important support for Calgarians with low income.

Three quarters of Calgarians agree concern for their personal safety is or would be a consideration when deciding whether or not to take public transit.

# **75%**

Three quarters of Calgarians do or would feel safe riding a CTrain alone during the day.

## 47%

Just less than one-half of Calgarians do or would feel safe riding a CTrain alone after dark.

## 86%

The majority of Calgarians do or would feel safe riding a Calgary Transit bus alone during the day.
