- With a Golf Call-In Card, you'll receive a personal barcode and family pin number allowing you to reserve, confirm, cancel or modify tee times at any City of Calgary Golf Course up to four days in advance. No credit card is required.

- Golfers without a Golf Call-In Card can reserve up to 48 hours in advance with a valid Visa or MasterCard only through 221-3510 or calling the clubhouse directly for same-day bookings.

The City of Calgary Golf Courses

R.C.G.A. Rules shall govern all play except where modified by local rules. The City of Calgary Golf Courses enforces golf etiquette and all the facility policies and procedures posted in clubhouses and on the #1 tee.

Local Rules

- Out of bounds – all fence lines – penalty stroke and distance.
- One club length relief from roads, pathways, screens and immovable objects inside the course. Ball may not be advanced closer to the hole – no penalty.
- Water hazards – yellow stakes. Lateral hazards – red stakes.
- A two-club length relief from any tagged tree shall be taken without penalty. Ball may not be advanced closer to the hole.

Safety is a Priority

- At The City of Calgary Golf Courses, maintenance equipment and workers have the right of way.
- DO NOT HIT onto the Green if the flagstick is out. Once the worker is out of the way, it is then safe to hit on to the Green.
- A maintenance worker may not be aware of your location or may be wearing hearing protection. Make every effort to get the worker's acknowledgement prior to making your shot. Yelling "Fore" or waving will usually get the workers attention.
- If at any time you or another member of your group loses control or sight of a shot, warn others by shouting "Fore".
- Do not hit until the group ahead is safely out of range.

Etiquette & Policies

- Replace divots, rake sand traps and repair ball marks.
- Move quickly on fairways and greens.
- Mark scores on next tee, not on greens.
- If you are more than one hole behind the group in front, allow the group following you to play through.
- Play only one ball.
- NO practising on tee boxes or putting surfaces.
- Keep power carts on paths where possible.
- Keep all pull carts 30 feet from the edge of greens, off tee boxes and out of sand traps.
- Play Ready Golf – disregard honour and who's away, if safe.
- Continuous putting is recommended.

Golfers may be held responsible for any personal injury or damage to equipment and property (City owned or privately owned) as a result of not adhering to safety procedures.
