BYLAW NUMBER 10M2013

BEING A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF CALGARY TO REPEAL BYLAW 58M2006, THE VOTER IDENTIFICATION BYLAW

WHEREAS Council enacted Bylaw 58M2006, The Voter Identification Bylaw, pursuant to section 53(1) of the *Local Authorities Election Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-21;

AND WHEREAS the <u>Local Authorities Election Act</u> has since been amended by the <u>Election Accountability Amendment Act</u>, 2012, S.A. 2012, c. 5,

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the amended <u>Local Authorities Election Act</u>, Council no longer possesses the jurisdiction to enact a bylaw regarding voter identification for a local election;

AND WHEREAS the amended <u>Local Authorities Election Act</u> now provides for the forms of authorized identification for a local election;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALGARY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Bylaw 58M2006, The Voter Identification Bylaw, as amended, is hereby repealed.
- 2. This Bylaw comes into force on the day it is passed.
