Innovation district

CONSIDERATIONS

- Consider a design that is coordinated, flexible and responsive as well as considers the effective cohabitation of innovation and core service delivery to customers located in the district.
- Consider establishing two innovation districts high density (highly controlled) and industrial (fewer constraints to test such things as autonomous vehicles).
- Other key stakeholders (e.g. smaller tech companies) will be interested and should be invited at the appropriate time.

ACTIONS

- David Basto will coordinate the next chartering/planning session which will be facilitated by an IT Project Manager. Key questions to answer include: scope, timeline (3 month sprint versus 3 year project), geographic area(s) and outcomes.
