## **CHAIR'S OPENING REMARKS**

The purpose of today's meeting is to assure alignment of expectations between the project team and LTAC. In addition, some concern has been raised on the question of value for money given industry is paying for the governance review through the license fees it pays whereas the question of "who benefits" goes beyond industry.

The Chair noted the concern, but given the language of the motion adopted by Council it was clear that Council intended the cost of the review be paid for from LTAC funds. The Chair noted the balance of the LTS reserve (\$4.1M) and indicated that while there were clearly funds available, the amount being held in the reserve appeared to be excessive and indicated that a review of the reserve, the disposition of surplus funds being held in the reserve was work that should be undertaken in the near future. Given the expansion of the industry in the past 18 months, disposition of surplus funds and future funding must be carefully considered.
