Crime Prevention Investment Plan (CPIP) Call for Funding

The City of Calgary has a new funding opportunity for local non-profit organizations. The Crime Prevention Investment Plan (CPIP) supports social development projects that seek to influence the root social and economic causes of crime. The long-term goal of CPIP is to reduce criminal offending or re-offending and enhance the well-being of individuals. Organizations interested in receiving CPIP funds must first submit a letter of intent by **August 24 by 4:00 p.m. (MST)**. Full details are available at <http://www.calgary.ca/fundingproposals>

Announcement from A/Director on Recent Changes in Calgary Neighbourhoods

As many of you are aware, Calgary Neighbourhoods is undergoing a restructuring that will result in changes to roles and positions for the staff you've connected with through our prevention funding programs including FCSS and CPIP.

Beginning in the fall, the partnership management function of the prevention funding program will be led by the newly established [Office of Partnerships in Calgary Neighbourhoods](#). Through this Office, The City will provide a coordinated approach to partnerships and services for partner organizations. Your main point of contact will change from a Social Planner to a Partnership Consultant, some of whom may be the same person, while others may be new to their role. Either way, they will be dedicated to providing partnership management to you and your organization.



We will provide additional details and advise you of any change in your primary point of contact as we begin to implement the structural changes.

Also, I'd like to take this opportunity to let you know about some recent shifts in leadership, Katie Black has taken on a dedicated role to help prepare our department for The City's next service plan and budget cycle to be approved by Council at the end of the year. During her absence, I am acting in the

role of director of Calgary Neighbourhoods. In addition, our General Manager of Community Services, Kurt Hanson will retire on July 31, 2018. We'll keep you updated on other leadership changes as they occur.
