

Enmax Legacy Parks Program — Memorial Drive

Project: Working from the Council-approved *Memorial Drive—Landscape of Memory Plan*, this project includes restoration work and improvements to the commemorative older areas of Memorial Drive. Parkway work including streetscape improvements, plazas and a soldiers' memorial. Public use of the heritage Kensington Fire Hall is planned.

Budget: \$30.0M Enmax Legacy Parks Program total budget over multiple phases.

Timeline: Centre Street to 14 Street N.W. completion in 2012-2013.
Soldiers' Memorial Site completion in 2011.

Benefits: A significant commemoration to the Calgarians who have served in Canada's military, this 30 block upgrade along the Bow River north shore and Memorial Drive will be extensively used by pathway users as well as those with military ties for both recreation and reflection.
