Overall Themes

- > The park is and should be for the use of all citizens.
- > A management plan must preserve the natural state of the park and focus on its long-term sustainability.
- > The plan should be limited to restoring the park to its natural state and not include developments that will attract more users.
- > The park needs improved maintenance.

Environmental Conservation

- > Protect the river, slopes and river banks.
- > Natural environment is protected and enhanced.
- > Park sustainability is maximized.
- > All intact natural areas are preserved.
- > Native vegetative areas are protected/restored.

Connectivity / Circulation

- > Vehicular, bicycle and pedestrian circulation is improved and made safer.
- > Active modes of transportation are favoured over vehicular.

User Benefits

- > Conflicts are reduced among different user groups.
- > Park improvements benefit a wide variety of user groups.
- > Users show increased respect for the park, and alter their behavior.

Community Impacts

- > Reduce impacts of park use on the adjacent community.
- > Promote park stewardship through public education, volunteer opportunities and improved signage.
