Pathways & Safety

- Need a paved pathway from 38 Ave. to 14A St. (diagonal)
- Safety issues between multi-users on pathways
- Need a North-south pathway (paved) along 14A St. (west edge)
- Provide off leash on the east side of River Park and restrict dogs on the west side
- Development for users safety
 - Safety on the Sandy Beach pathway (dog issues)
 - o On 14A St. a barrier for dogs that is attractive with few openings
- Don't agree with a paved pathway in the middle of River Park
- Formal study about the path usage
- Keep trials as they are (no maintenance)
- Paved/gravel pathway in River Park
- Have a decent path down Britannia Slopes and enforce use of this to reduce erosion
- Paved pathways should address user safety even snow and gravel clearing as possible
