## eConstruction Drawing and Permission to Construct

To submit Construction Drawings and Permission to Construct requests online, applicants must become a registered user to log onto The City of Calgary's website – **VISTA**. To request an account and ID, visit <u>calgary.ca/vista</u>. One account/ID will be assigned per organization.

Applicants must accept the terms of the eConstruction Drawings that are outlined on the online application form and provide all required data on the online application forms.

To expedite the evaluation, all materials submitted must be clear, legible and precise. To maintain a high level of quality in customer service, staff have been instructed to accept only complete applications which include plans prepared to professional drafting standards.

		Electronic Drawings must be submitted in a <b>single</b> , <b>multi-page</b> Auto Desk DWF file (Design Web Format) as outlined in the section below. Applicants can access the free <u>AutoDesk DWF Writer</u> for use.

		If submitting a Subdivision Design, provide copies of the Tentative Plan and the CPC Approved and STAMPED Outline Plan (Development Agreement) in the drawing set.		
		If submitting a Short Main Extension Design for Indemnification Agreement, provide a copy of a legal or site plan in the drawing set		
		Cost estimate from an indemnified contractor in PDF format (Indemnification Agreement)		
		Authenticated Plans required for ALL construction drawing submissions (SIGNED and STAMPED, in PDF format)		
		Detailed Cover Letter, SIGNED by the applicant, outlining the project scope, details, and justifications (in PDF format). Detailed Cover Letter templates: Initial Submission; Subsequent Submission.		
		At Preliminary submission, must submit Alberta Environment SIGNED and STAMPED Letter of Authorization (LOA) ( <u>Item 1B</u> ) application form, complete with project data sheet ( <u>Item 1A</u> )		
0	3.	DWF File Structure (Note: consolidated file versus individual files)		
		Submit a single DWF file containing a title sheet, index sheet, comment sheet, approved/stamped Outline Plan, Tentative Plan, all cover sheets, all block profiles and any other drawings as named in item #5		



		Files must be 2D DWF file print-ready (i.e. set up properly for printing with title block, no extra data outside the print page area)			
		Files must be monochrome with white background (print-ready)			
0	4.	Standards
