In preparation for the Green Line LRT, The City will be completing several Enabling Works construction projects along the future Green Line alignment. These projects include utility relocations and land preparation. Doing this work now ensures the right-of-way will be ready for major Green Line construction scheduled to start in 2020.

Throughout 2019, enabling works construction projects will be happening in the area of 107 Avenue and 27 Street S.E. In order to prepare the area for the Green Line, multiple utilities need to be modified or relocated.

SHALLOW UTILITY RELOCATIONS February 25 – late June 2019

ENMAX, Telus and Shaw crews will be working in the utility right-of way south of 107 Avenue S.E., parallel to 27 Street S.E. This work includes:

- Replacing some existing distribution (telephone) poles
- Modifying transformers and underground cable routes for power and telecommunications cables

What to Expect

Crews will be working Monday to Friday, from 7:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. along City-owned laneways and boulevards south of 107 Avenue S.E. (see photo). During construction hours you can expect:

- Some excavation work along the laneway.
- Temporary fencing will be in place for the duration of construction, so access to the laneway will be limited.
- Access to all commercial buildings will be maintained.
- An increase in construction activity and noise.
- Remediation of the laneway will take place when weather permits.



Impacts

Crews will be working in the utility right-of-way south of 107 Avenue S.E., parallel to 27 Street S.E. During this work you can expect an increase in construction activity and noise. Work is expected to last approximately four months.

Due to excavation work in the laneway, temporary fencing will be in place for the safety of the public and crews working on the site. Access to all commercial buildings will be maintained throughout construction work.
