INFORMATION **Shepard Road S.E. utility relocation**
NOTICE **Construction starts February 11, 2019**

In preparation for the Green Line LRT, The City will be completing several Enabling Works construction projects along the future Green Line alignment. These projects include utility relocations and land preparation. Doing this work now ensures the right-of-way will be ready for major Green Line construction scheduled to start in 2020.

Throughout 2019, enabling works construction projects will be happening in the area of Shepard Road and 90 Avenue S.E. In order to prepare the area for the Green Line, and future development, multiple utilities need to be relocated.

SHALLOW UTILITY RELOCATIONS
February 11 – April 2019

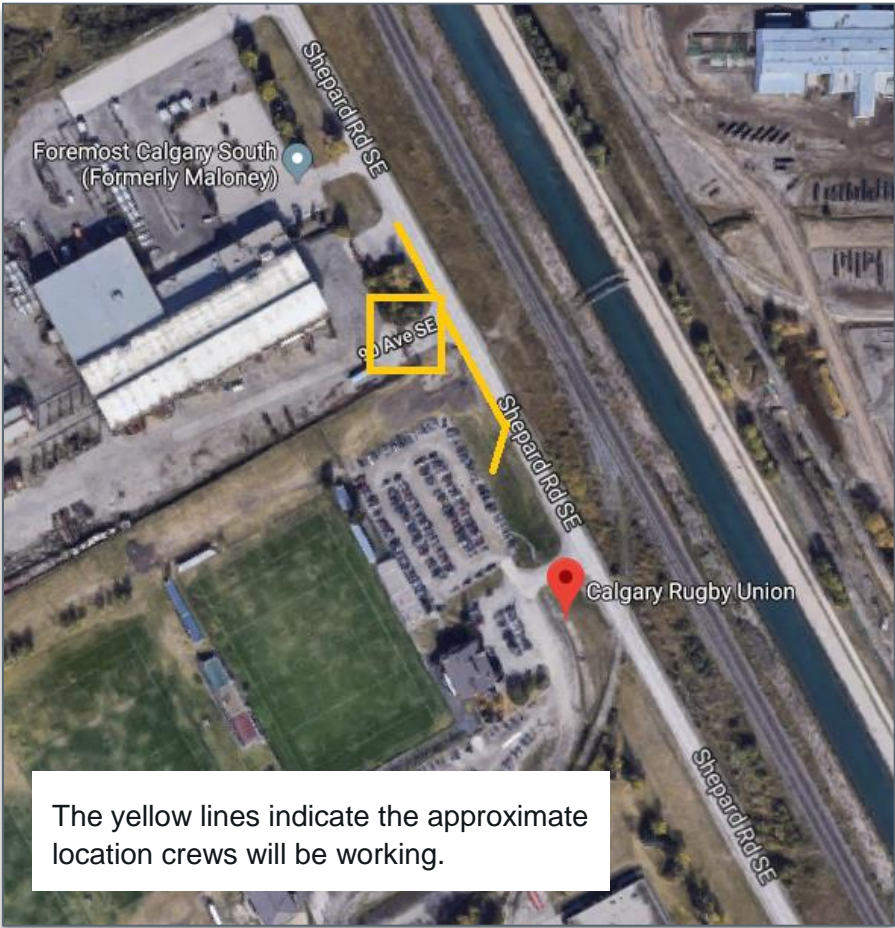
ENMAX, Telus and Shaw crews will be working in the area of Shepard Road and 90 Avenue S.E. This work includes:

- Removing and replacing some existing distribution poles.
- Burying overhead powerlines.
- Relocating existing telecommunications infrastructure.

What to Expect

Crews will be working Monday to Friday, from 7:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. along City-owned roadways and boulevards. During construction hours you can expect:

- Excavation will take place west of Shepard Road S.E.
- Access to all commercial buildings will be maintained throughout construction.
- Some trees and shrubbery will be removed.



The yellow lines indicate the approximate location crews will be working.

- Remediation of the area will take place in spring 2019 when weather conditions permit.

Impacts

Crews will be working in the utility right-of-way located along Shepard Road S.E. and 90 Avenue S.E. During this work, you can expect an increase in construction activity and minor noise vibrations.

Access to the parking lot in the southeast corner of the Foremost property, located at 8825 Shepard Road S.E., will be restricted during construction. Temporary fencing will be placed on site while crews are working in this area.
