Preparing for the Green Line LRT: Ramsay Utility Work – 11 Street S.E. and 26 Ave S.E.

11 Street S.E. utility relocation starting April 3, 2019

In preparation for the Green Line LRT, The City will be completing several Enabling Works construction projects along the future Green Line alignment. These projects include utility relocations and land preparation. Doing this work now ensures the right-of-way will be ready for major Green Line construction scheduled to start on tracks and stations in 2020.

Throughout early 2019, enabling works construction projects will be ongoing in the area of 11 Street S.E. and 26 Avenue S.E. In order to prepare the area for Green Line, multiple utilities need to be relocated.

11 Street S.E. / 26 Avenue S.E. traffic impacts April 3 – July

Crews will be working along 11 St. S.E. and 26 Ave S.E. over the course of the next 3 months and various detours and parking restrictions will need to be in place to allow for the relocation of Shaw, TELUS, and ENMAX utilities. Two-way traffic will be maintained along 11 St. S.E. and 26 Ave. S.E. but motorists are reminded to follow detour signage in the area.

Large truck detours

Large trucks will be detoured off southbound 11 St S.E. onto Portland St. S.E. to allow for safe passage through the area.

Pedestrian access along 11 St. S.E. and 26 Ave. S.E. will be maintained.



Bus detours

April 3 – May 15

Beginning Wednesday, April 3, various Calgary Transit routes will be detoured around construction via Portland Street S.E. Bus stops 5865, 4505,3876, and 3913 will be relocated to Portland St. SW.
