



Getting Around Calgary

To increase options for getting around the city and to improve safety and predictability for Calgarians, we have updated some of the transportation bylaws.

Safe passing bylaw

When driving at speeds slower than 60 km/hr, you are required to leave a minimum distance of 1m when passing a person cycling. When driving at speeds faster than 60 km/hr, the minimum passing distance increases to 1.5 m.

Where can I skateboard, scooter, and in-line skate downtown and around Calgary?

People skateboarding, scooting and in-line skating are welcome to use the cycle track network and bike lanes across the city.

Plan on getting around using these modes?

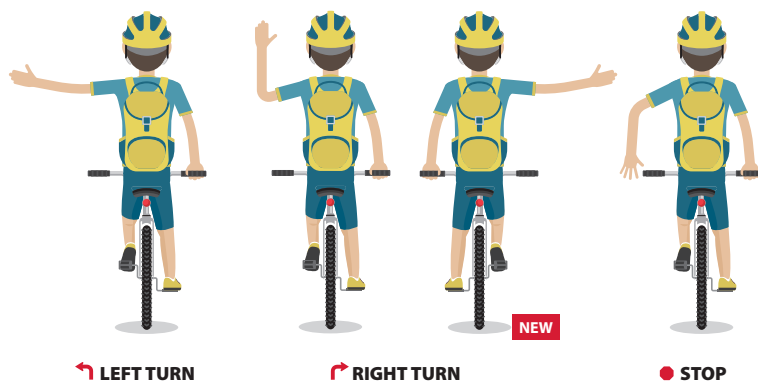
Make sure you use lights at night and follow the same rules of the road as someone cycling in these locations.

Yielding when entering a roadway from a pathway

When cycling, please yield when you transition from a pathway to a roadway. Remember to yield to people walking.

Hand signals for people cycling

People cycling are able to use either arm to indicate a right turn.



LEFT TURN

RIGHT TURN

People cycling are now able to use either arm to indicate a right turn. (See diagram)

People skateboarding, scooting and in-line skating are welcome to use the cycle track network and bike lanes across the city.

Slow down, look both ways when entering a crosswalk.

People cycling may now yield instead of coming to a full stop when entering a roadway or sidewalk from a pathway.



Yield to people walking.

Faster than 60 km/h

If you are driving slower than 60 km/hr, leave a minimum of 1 metre of space when passing someone cycling. If you are driving faster than 60 km/hr, the minimum space increases to 1.5 metres.

If you can't pass safely with the minimum amount of space, slow down and wait for an appropriate opportunity to pass. You may cross a single solid yellow line to complete a pass, if it's safe to do so.
