<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paper & cardboard • Plastic food containers, jugs & bottles (labelled with a recycling symbol #1-7) • Stretchy plastic bags & wrap (please bundle) • Metal cans & foil • Glass jars & bottles • Drink cups, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Paper coffee cups - Plastic drink cups 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anything that can be returned to a bottle depot: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Drink pouches - Juice boxes - Glass beverages containers - Aluminum cans - Plastic beverage containers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certified compostable food ware – wooden/bamboo • Food scraps, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Meat, fish & bones - Fruit & vegetables - Bread & noodles - Eggshells & dairy • Paper & cardboard soiled with grease or food • Paper plates • Napkins & tissues • Wood popsicle sticks or stir sticks 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foam containers & packaging • Plastic plates, cutlery, straws and drink lids (even if it has a recycling symbol #1-7) • Used packaging or non-stretchy bags, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Chip bags - Chocolate bar wrappers - Sugar packets - Milk creamers • Non-recyclable metals

Ultimately, remember the rule of thumb: When in doubt, throw it out!
