

City of Calgary User Fee & Subsidy Policy Review



- Fully tax-supported services are funded through property tax and other taxes.
 - These City services benefit society as a whole and are equally available to all citizens.
 - Users are not excluded for non-payment.
- Partially tax-supported services benefit both individuals and society at large
 - These City services are funded by both user fees and taxes.
 - User fees do not recover the full cost of providing the service.
 - Users can be excluded for non-payment
- Non tax-supported services primarily benefit the individual using the service.
 - These City services are funded through user fees, which recover the full cost of providing the service.
 - Users can be excluded for non-payment.
- Licenses, permits and approvals are used to regulate the use of, or changes to, private property.
 - Users can be fined for non-compliance.
