## Wins of the Week Highlights, Successes & Milestones

- The Community Outreach Team (COT) and Calgary Police Service District 2 officers completed a joint outreach operation on CTrains on the West LRT.
- A person who doesn't have a fixed address approached a Transit peace officer and asked for assistance. The officer referred the client to the COT team, who was able to connect the client with the resources he needed. The Diversion team and the Calgary Drop-in Centre are currently working on getting the client a bus ticket to return to his home in Edmonton.
- The COT team often assists the vulnerable population with obtaining identification. This is a
  critical step to overcoming one of the barriers members of the vulnerable population face to
  access housing and income supports.

## Upcoming Initiative

- A six-week marketing campaign to promote the Transit Watch service will begin on May 1. Anecdotal evidence indicates limited awareness of the service. This campaign is anticipated to increase awareness of the Transit Watch service and encourage Transit riders to report unsafe behaviours with the option. The campaign will include:
  - o A social media strategy
  - o Radio and Spotify advertisements
  - A YouTube video
  - Outdoor advertising at Transit stations, platforms and on CTrains and buses
