### Upcoming Initiatives

- 14 in-house Corporate Security officers will join Transit Public Safety on Feb. 27. When recruitment and training are complete, we will have a total of 31 Corporate Security officers supporting Transit Safety.
- We are finalizing the class details for the peace officer recruit class that will start on Feb. 27. This will be a joint induction training class that includes both Community Standards and Transit peace officers (24 in total).
