


XV OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES INVENTORY TO THE RECORDS OF THE COMMUNICATIONS GROUP PART III

XXII. Communications Group, Culture Division, Olympic Arts Festival, Supervisor, Arts Production Tom McCarthy. -- 1986-1988. -- .63 m of text.

Administrative History: Tom McCarthy is first listed on the organizational charts of OCO'88 as Supervisor, Arts Production in 1986 July. However, correspondence to and from him is evident in the records as early as March of that year. His position was also known as "Supervisor, Production," and he reported to Arts Festival Manager, Michael Tabbitt. On one occasion, McCarthy was also referred to as "Staff Liaison, Community Working, Film and Music Committees."

Scope and Content: These records came to the Archives in several binders and labelled "Communications, Arts Festival, Administration files." The documents have been removed from the binders, but are in no particular order.

The series title is taken from the contents of the records.

XXIII. Communications Group, Artificial Series, Printed Material, Ephemera and Cultural Historic Items. -- 1981-1988. -- 5.29 m of secondary sources and other material.

Administrative History: This artificial series was created because a large number of Olympic-related publications, printed material, posters, ephemera and cultural historic items were among the records of OCO'88 but not necessarily identified with any particular administrative unit. The moving boxes containing this material were often labelled, for example, like "Misc. Last Minute." All of this material has been brought together in this series

Scope and Content: Some of the publications were previously catalogued by OCO'88 staff/volunteers and have catalogue numbers on them. Other publications were not catalogued, so the significance of the catalogued items has been lost and, therefore, these numbers are not referred to in the file listing below.

This series has been divided into nine sub series: General Publications, CODA Publications, OCO'88 Publications, Correspondence and Minutes, Sound Recording, Photo Prints and Slides, OCO'88 General (these files often contain other material as well as printed material), Video and Film, Cultural Historic Items, and Posters. Oversize materials have been placed in either oversize Hollinger boxes or into map folders in Map Cabinet 1. Specific locations are referred to in the file listing below.

The other material consists of approximately 297 cultural historic items, approximately 223 flags, 157 slides, 89 pins, 74 badges, 67 posters, 29 photo prints, approximately 20 buttons, ten certificates, nine banners, six videos, three films, three plates, three plans, two postcards, two medals (medallions), one sound disk, one blueprint and .5 m of text.

The title of the series is based on the contents of the boxes.
