To His Worship the Mayor, Commissioner and City Council:

Gentlemen:

I beg to submit the Parks and Playgrounds Report for the year 1943.

ST. GEORGE'S ISLAND ZOO

All buildings, pens, cages, etc., have been kept in a good state of repair during the year.

Material for an iron guard rail in front of the bird pens was donated to the Zoological Society and erected by the Parks' Department.

The general health of the exhibits was good on the whole, there being a few losses among the birds due to roup. The most serious loss was the sea lion, which the Zoological Society hopes to replace very shortly.

Twenty five spruce trees were planted in front of the new zoo paddock.

The attendance was good.

PARKS

Mount Pleasant Park

The hillside facing south was seeded to grass and planted with trees and shrubs. The area seeded was approximately 32,560 square feet. Eighteen trees and three hundred and seventy five shrubs were planted. 400 feet of new water service was installed.

Mount Pleasant Rotary Recreation Ground

The north end and the west side was loamed and seeded, the area being 50,600 square feet. A new shrubbery border was laid out and planted with seventy five shrubs.

Riley Park

The trees and shrubs were very much over grown and were pruned very heavily, thereby improving the appearance of the park and benefiting the health of the shrubs.

All parks and plots were planted with annuals and maintained as usual.

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GOLF COURSE

The mens' No. 11 green was converted to a grass green, and the excavating of No. 1 and 18 was done ready to seed in 1944.

The ladies' course was greatly improved by removing boulders from the fairways and returfing the line of the water ditch through fairways No. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Each playground held a weiner roast, and permission was granted by the Fire Department to have these fires.

Cinema Shows

The managers of the Crescent and Garry Theatres put on special shows, viz., "Mrs. Wiggs of the Cabbage Patch" and a "Jack Benny" picture, respectively, for the nominal charge of five cents.

Exhibition of Handicrafts

The children did some excellent handicraft work, which was put on display at the end of the season in one of the Hudson's Bay Company's show windows.

RINKS

Sixty nine rinks were operated this year. Five were supervised by city employees, and eight by the communities in which the rinks were situated. Checking fees were charged at Hillhurst Rink and the total receipts were \$ 78.80.

BOULEVARDS

The cost of tree removals again exceeded the amount provided in the estimates. Four hundred and ninety eight trees were taken out, at a cost of \$ 5,079.32. I quite expect we shall be asked to replace most of these trees this spring.

CEMETERIES

Queen's Park

New gates were erected at the entrance. Space on the west side of the entrance was filled in, levelled, loamed and seeded to grass, and flower borders were made and planted on the east and west sides.

New roads from Section "D" north to Section "E", from Section "E" to "F", from Section "D" to "F" and from Section "B" to "C" were graded and gravelled.

Forty three new blocks were laid out on Sections "A", "B", "D" and "F".

A ditch was cut from the south fence to the bridge, thus diverting the creek. A trench was also made outside the fence on the south side to drain away storm water.

A new water service (15,000 feet) was installed.
