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## **BACKGROUND**

The Centre City Plan is a comprehensive and strategic long term vision for the future of Calgary's Centre City. The Plan includes the area bounded by the Bow River on the North, the Elbow River on the East, the Elbow River and 17 Avenue South on the South and 14 Street SW on the West.

The Plan presents a new vision for the Centre City to be a livable, thriving and caring place. To achieve this, the Plan includes both policies and actions to guide the growth of the Centre City. Main topic areas covered by the Plan include:

- Vision and principles
- Sustainment strategy
- Overall urban structure
- Neighbourhood planning
- Special area policies
- Open spaces/riverfront
- Movement and access systems
- Urban design, architecture and the public realm
- Vitality
- Community building

The Plan replaces the Core Area Policy Brief and the Downtown Handbook of Public Improvements. It does not supercede other Council approved statutory plans, policy briefs or bylaws in the area. However, it will be used as a guide for the amendment or replacement of existing policy over time, where required.
