Discover upcoming Green Line LRT construction with our interactive map!

To help Calgarians see what's being built along the Green Line LRT route, we've created an interactive map that shows active construction sites, as well as stations and the route.

All Green Line construction information can be found on this map, which you can use to understand how construction will impact you and your future commutes.

Exploring the map is simple and intuitive. Zoom in to find project locations along specific streets and communities or select a station from the list to jump directly to its location. Hover over station markers to preview renderings and use the home icon to return to the full alignment and view all current road closures. Typing home or workplace addresses into the search bar allows users to see current and future projects happening near them. Clicking the construction zones outlined in red reveals important updates, impacts, and timelines.

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Use this map to find information related to upcoming construction to remain informed and prepared as construction continues. To explore the Green Line Interactive Map, visit maps.calgary.ca/greenline.

Student Fire Safety

Whether you are living on campus or off-campus, it is important to check that your accommodation meets fire codes and provides fire safety equipment. Smoke alarms and fire extinguishers, combined with a home safety plan, will increase your ability to escape safely in the event of a fire. Carbon monoxide alarms will alert you to exposure, as this poisonous gas has no colour, smell or taste.

Make sure that you are cooking, charging devices and disposing of smoking materials correctly. Knowing how to do so will help to keep you and your roommates safe and prevent fires from starting.

If you are renting a secondary suite, you can check the Secondary Suite Registry to ensure that the property is legal and safe. Registered suites have been inspected by The City of Calgary and the Calgary Fire Department for compliance with building and fire safety requirements.
