



Unemployment Rates, Canada and Provinces (Seasonally adjusted)










Calgary: Regular Employment Insurance




Alberta: Regular Employment Insurance (Seasonally adjusted)









Average Natural Gas Price










Alberta Average Wage Inflation (year-over-year, per cent)


































