## Water Efficiency Plan

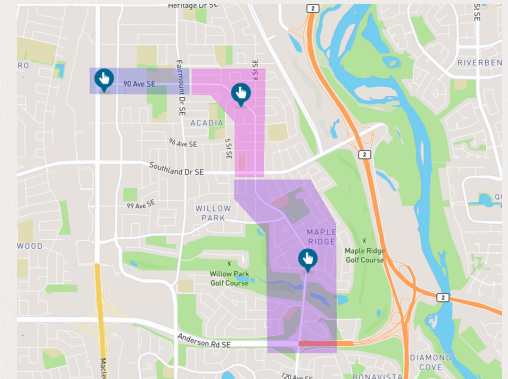


City Council recently approved Calgary’s new Water Efficiency Plan, aimed at reducing water use and managing peak summer demand. A key feature is a year-round outdoor watering schedule, which will be phased in over the coming years, as summer water use can be up to 40% higher than in winter.

Outdoor watering rules include:

- Up to 3 days per week (max 45 hours) for sprinklers/irrigation
- Even addresses: Tue/Thu/Sat | Odd: Wed/Fri/Sun
- Water during cooler hours (12 a.m. – 10 a.m. & 7 p.m. – midnight)
- Exemptions for trees, food gardens, and new landscaping

I voted against the plan. While I support responsible water use, Calgary is currently losing about 115 million litres of treated water daily due to leaks—equivalent to over 260,000 households annually. Fixing aging infrastructure, improving accountability, and addressing these system issues should come first before placing permanent changes on residents.



## Community Engagement

### 90 Ave & Acadia Drive S.E. Mobility Improvements

Ward 11 residents recently had the opportunity to learn more about the City’s proposed 90 Avenue/Acadia Drive Mobility Improvements project – an initiative focused on improving safety, accessibility, and connectivity for the communities of Acadia, Maple Ridge, and Willow Park.

Councillor Rob Ward and the Ward 11 team attended community engagement sessions at the Acadia Recreation Complex on April 30 and May 2 to speak directly with residents, answer questions, and hear feedback about the proposed improvements.

The project includes enhanced crosswalks, curb extensions, upgraded signals, improved signage and lighting, traffic calming measures, a lower speed limit, and a new multi-use pathway along the corridor to better support people walking, wheeling, and cycling. Thank you to everyone who attended the engagement sessions and helped shape the conversation about the future of mobility and safety in Ward 11.

- Some communities have multiple sweeping dates
- Schedules may change if needed
- Asterisk (\*) means sweeping takes place over 2 days\*
