WHEREAS The City of Calgary is committed to achieve 80 percent diversion of waste from City landfills by 2020;

AND WHEREAS The City of Calgary has successfully implemented Blue Cart Residential recycling collection;

AND WHEREAS The City continues to operate over 50 Community Recycling Depots;

AND WHEREAS The City operates and supports other diversion programs such as Household Hazardous Waste, electronics, backyard composting, through the sale of subsidised composters, and tire recycling, Christmas tree, fall leaf and pumpkin collection;

AND WHEREAS organics contribute more than a third to the residential waste stream;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT City Administration be directed to report no later than 2011 February through the Standing Policy Committee on Utilities and Environment on progress toward the 80/20 by 2020 waste diversion goal in the residential sector including:

- Opportunities to increase organics diversion
- Infrastructure requirements to manage organics
- Opportunities for multi-family residential recycling
- Key milestones to 2020

AND FURTHER BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that Administration be directed to report no later than 2011 May on the progress of the non-residential stream diversion.
