### ADDITIONAL RESOURCES IN SUPPORT OF CLEAN TO THE CORE INITIATIVE

#### Mayor Dave Bronconnier and Alderman Druh Farrell

WHEREAS the Clean to the Core initiative has now been in place for one year;

AND WHEREAS improvements have been realized as a result of Clean to the Core, including cleaning of graffiti, improved maintenance and appearance of streets, sidewalks and public transportation facilities, beautification of open spaces, implementation of the Public Behaviour Bylaw, and increased presence of police officers, bylaw officers, and Calgary Transit protective service officers;

AND WHEREAS Calgary's downtown and inner City need to continue to be safe, vital and appealing places to live, work, visit, and enjoy;


AND WHEREAS Calgarians have concerns regarding safety in specific areas of the downtown and inner City, and additional resources for protective services can assist in addressing these issues through active, "beat-oriented" presence and patrolling;

AND WHEREAS this methodology was proven to be a very successful deterrent to negative issues with the joint Police and Bylaw Community Support Officer pilot program;

AND WHEREAS in keeping with the "Broken Windows" approach to public safety, by working collaboratively all arms of our protective services can effectively address both petty and major crime in the downtown and beltline;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. Administration be directed to prepare the following adjustments to the 2008 Business Plan and Budget at the November budget deliberations:
  - a. 10 additional Calgary Police Service officers, over and above growth positions, for deployment in the downtown and beltline;

## NOTICES OF MOTION

Section 114 and 49(2) and (3), of the Procedure Bylaw 30M2002, as amended is as follows:

114(1) A Member, wishing to introduce a new matter for consideration, shall submit the motion in writing to the City Clerk.

See 49(2)

(2) On a Two-Thirds (10) Vote, the requirement for Notice contained in subsection (1) may be waived. However, the matter would then be considered as Urgent Business.

(3) Subject to subsection 49(2), all Notices of Motion received by the City Clerk shall be added to the Agenda of the next Regular Business Meeting.

49(2) All submissions in response to advertised Public Hearing matters, the titles and report numbers of all administrative reports and Notices of Motion from Members for the Agenda of a Regular Business Meeting shall be in the Office of the City Clerk no later than 10.00 a.m. on the Thursday, two (2) Thursdays before the Meeting.

(3) When the date for receipt of submissions falls on a statutory holiday, the date for receipt shall be the following business day

The City Clerk's Office will forward Notices of Motion directly to Council.

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


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- b. Creation of a Downtown and Inner City Bylaw Zone, that would recognize the unique needs of these areas, similar to the Community Support Officer Project staffed with 25 on the street Bylaw Officers;
  - c. Funding for mobile video surveillance units, including the capital purchase, operating, monitoring and evaluation of the effectiveness of the program, to be jointly coordinated by Animal and Bylaw Services and the Calgary Police Service, to assist with their enforcement and investigation efforts.
2. Administration be directed to:
- a. Notify the Calgary Police Commission of Council's intention to fund additional officers dedicated to the downtown and beltline, and Council's desire for enhanced coordination between the Calgary Police Service and Calgary Animal and Bylaw Services in this regard;
  - b. Offer the Police Commission assistance from City Administration in the Calgary Police Service's efforts to recruit new officers.
