RE: CALGARY POPPY FUND REMEMBRANCE CROSSES

WHEREAS white crosses were erected on Memorial Drive by the Royal Canadian Legion Calgary Poppy Fund during the week of Remembrance Day;

AND WHEREAS each cross represented a fallen soldier from the Calgary region;

AND WHEREAS this commemoration is planned for future years at the same location;

AND WHEREAS the organizers of the Remembrance Crosses have expressed a desire to name this portion of the parkway as a permanent reminder of this commemoration;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that City Council direct Administration to work with the Naming Committee, the Calgary Poppy Fund and the Memorial Drive Landscape of Memory stakeholders to rename the green space on the North side of Memorial Drive, located between Centre St and the Calgary Curling Club.
