Substation No. 1	Downtown	Ongoing until Q3 2026	Construction for the new ENMAX No. 1 Substation site. Traffic will be impacted in the area. ENMAX will notify impacted businesses and share traffic impacts on our website.
Werklund Centre (previously Arts Common)	Downtown	Construction anticipated to begin in Q2 2026	ENMAX will be upgrading the electrical infrastructure to support the Werklund Centre expansion
Greenline Utility Realignment	Downtown	Ongoing until Q1 2027	ENMAX is relocating and modifying electrical infrastructure along 2 St SW, from 7 Ave SW to north Eau Claire
Olympic Plaza Transformation	Downtown	Construction timelines not yet available	ENMAX will be upgrading the electrical infrastructure to support the Olympic Plaza Transformation project
32 Avenue NW Transmission Line (16.60L & 21.6L)	Varsity & University District	AUC application approved, no construction requirements	ENMAX acquired AUC approval to make the temporary overhead line permanent
No.20 Substation Switchgear Replacement	West Hillhurst	Ongoing until Q4 2027	ENMAX will be upgrading the existing substation’s electrical infrastructure

Central Calgary Transmission Line Relocation Project (3.82L)	Downtown West End, Hillhurst, Sunnyside, Rosedale, Crescent Heights & Balmoral	Public engagement is underway	ENMAX is proposing to upgrade and relocate the underground electrical infrastructure currently beneath the Bow River
No. 5 Substation Switchgear Replacement	Victoria Park SE	Ongoing until Q4 2027	ENMAX will be upgrading the existing substation's electrical infrastructure
Northwest Calgary 20.82/1.81L Transmission Line Alteration Project	West Hillhurst	The application has been filed with the AUC. Indigenous engagement is ongoing. Construction anticipated to begin in Q3 2026	ENMAX is proposing to upgrade and relocate overhead electrical infrastructure for flood mitigation planning
Scotia Place Events Centre	Beltline	Ongoing until Q3 2026	ENMAX will be upgrading the electrical infrastructure to support the development of the Scotia Place Events Centre
Overhead cable replacement program	Montgomery	Ongoing until Q4 2026	ENMAX is replacing aging overhead electrical infrastructure along Home Road NW
Inglewood Bridge	Downtown	Construction timeline not yet available	ENMAX will be upgrading the electrical infrastructure to support the refurbishment of the Inglewood Bridge
Stephen Avenue Redevelopment	Downtown	Construction timeline not yet available	ENMAX will be upgrading the electrical infrastructure to support the redevelopment of Stephen Avenue

Infrastructure maintenance	Beltline	January 2026 until Q2 2026	ENMAX is rebuilding underground electrical infrastructure at 13 St SW between 11 Ave SW & 12 Ave SW
Infrastructure maintenance	Beltline	Ongoing until Q2 2026	ENMAX is replacing underground electrical infrastructure at 17 Ave SW between 14 St SW & 12 St SW

ENMAX Power prepares quarterly ward update documents to provide City Councilors with advance notice of ENMAX Power projects in their ward, offering early insight to help prepare for potential resident impacts and public inquiries, while also serving as a direct line into ENMAX for timely information and support.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS
