

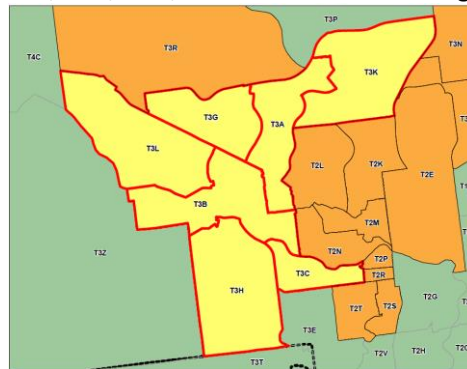

PRIORITY ITEMS

Canada Post Community Mailboxes changes

Over the coming years, Canada Post will convert nearly four million addresses that still receive door-to-door delivery to community mailboxes. More information has been sent to affected households. Postal codes that will be changing in 2027: T3B, T3C, T3H, T3L, T3A, T3G, T3K. More will be changed over by 2030:

Traffic Safety NoM Public Safety with a Purpose: Addressing Social Disorder in Calgary Calgary Plan Update Westbrook Station Area Masterplan	“I brought a motion to put up to \$6 million into community traffic safety. Council passed it 15 to 0. Crosswalk beacons, speed cushions, curb extensions, safer streets, safer kids. Administration brings the program to Council in September. One of the main topics in our inboxes is traffic safety concerns, so my team and I are excited to work with our communities and tackle as many of these problem spots as we can, as soon as possible. Check out my socials to watch my debate.” Update: this passed committee today, and will be going to council for further debate later this month. “Over the past several months since starting my role as City Councillor, I’ve heard from many Calgarians about a growing sense of unease in our public spaces.” Read More about the work we are doing. We will be hosting community engagement on this, coming later this month. Updates will be posted on our site. Currently, work is being done to drill holes to do environmental studies on the site and engagement on the park space will happen later this month. Updates will be posted on our site.
Hot topics in the Ward 8 office	
26 Avenue S.W. improvements Other Project Updates:	Construction is expected to begin in the coming days, starting with water utility upgrades between 14 Street SW and 18 Street SW. To reduce impacts, the project has been divided into east and west segments on either side of Crowchild Trail, each with its own construction phases. Phase 1 of the west segment (25 St SW to 26 St SW) begins this month, while Phase 1 of the east segment (14 St SW to 16 St SW) will begin once utility work is complete.
