FAMILY VIOLENCE IS A CRIME: It is against the law for a person to assault another person, regardless of their relationship. You do not deserve to be assaulted; it is not your fault nor are you responsible for your partner's conduct. You should know that you are not alone - the police and community resources can provide you with assistance.

YOU HAVE MADE A POSITIVE STEP to prevent further violence in your home. It is important for you to know that once a charge has been laid, neither you nor the police have the authority to have it withdrawn; only the Crown Prosecutor has this authority. If you change your address please advise the police so that they will be able to advise you about court dates.

IN ADDITION TO CALLING THE POLICE for intervention and protection, you may have police request an Emergency Protection Order for you or you may apply for a Queen's Bench Protection Order, a Restraining Order or a Peace Bond

EMERGENCY PROTECTION ORDER (EPO): You may qualify to apply for an EPO in an emergency family violence situation. The EPO can order the abuser to stay away from you, your children and your home (even if the

abuser lives there or owns the property) and provides you with the time needed to make arrangements to make yourself and your children safe. There is no cost to obtain an EPO.

An EPO may also be applied for by police, on your behalf and with your consent, when they conduct an investigation. An EPO may be granted by a Judge or Justice of the Peace when the police have investigated and the following conditions are met:

- That family violence has occurred,
- That you have reason to believe that the family member will continue or resume carrying out family violence, and
- That, by reason of seriousness or urgency, the order should be granted to provide immediate protection for you and other family members who reside with you.
