ENFORCEMENT

Start Smart Stay Safe: Children's Project

- Partnership with School Boards
- Safety education program for students from K to Gr. 12 that helps students make good decisions, develop resilience, avoid risky behavior and victimization
- Complementary parental program with similar messaging

Multi Agency School Support Team

- Facilitates a collaborative and comprehensive approach to support children (K – Gr. 6), identified by schools as exhibiting high risk and negative behavior, or being at increased risk of victimization

Integrated School Support Project

- Prevention-based pilot initiative in two elementary schools, to ensure students and their families receive necessary support
- Merges a number of new and existing programs
- Creates a supportive environment for a child to attain personal success, both socially and academically
- Wraparound approach, encompassing nutrition, fitness, academic success, emotional well-being and building a safe and strong community

YouthLink Calgary Police Interpretive Centre

- Delivers content and programming to encourage youth to confront issues, make positive life choices, and become responsible citizens
- Educate kids about gangs, drugs, online safety, domestic violence, and policing
- Empowers youth to make informed choices and be more resilient

Cadet Corps

- 12-18 age group
- Students with social, economic, or cultural diversity
- Promote leadership, citizenship and a policing career

Auxiliary Cadets

- 18+ age group

Child Advocacy Centre

- Streamlined co-located, interagency response to victims of child abuse and their families
- Coordination of investigation, crisis response and therapeutic services
- Representation from the police, Crown, Alberta Health Services, Alberta Children & Youth Services

School Resource Officers

Police & Crisis Team

- Police officers partnered with mental health clinicians
- Provide onsite assessment of at-risk individuals, for mental health, addictions or homelessness
- Provide transport to SORCe
- Form 10 or arrest

Safe Communities Opportunity & Resource Centre (SORCe)

- Coordination and alignment of existing community resources to provide quicker links to services, supports and solutions

Integrated Justice Services Project

- Diversion Sentencing Option
- Treatment
