

4th Quarter 2024 Statistical Report

Executive Summary

- Total violent crime in the 4th Quarter was 9% above the 5-year average and in line with volume in the 4th Quarter of 2023. Assaults increased 12% in the 4th Quarter with above average volumes noted across several assault types. At the end of 2024, violent crime was up 13% compared to the 5-year average.
- There were 5 homicides during the 4th Quarter of 2024 (slightly less than the 5-year average). Two of the five homicides were domestic-motivated. The year ended with 18 homicides, down 8 from average (26). Five of the homicides in 2024 were domestic-motivated.
- Reported sexual offences were 11% below average in the 4th Quarter and 4% below average by the end of the year.
- The 4th Quarter saw 8% more robberies than average (driven by an increase of person robberies). Most of 2024 saw an above average volume of robberies (the last three quarters) noting an 8% by year-end. Commercial and person robberies were most notably above average in 2024.
- The presence of weapons in violent crime was 12% higher than the 5-year average during the 4th Quarter with increases across most weapon types. By year-end, there was a 14% increase in the presence of weapons with only a few reductions noted including firearms.
- Property crime volumes were 8% below the 5-year average in the 4th Quarter and 16% below average by the end of 2024. Almost all property crime types noted a decline this year (with the exception of fraud).
- The number of victims of domestic violence increased 6% in the 4th Quarter from the 5-year average and 14% above average by the end of 2024.
- The total number of young offenders identified was 7% lower than the 5-year average during the 4th Quarter driven mostly by a reduction in property crime involvement. The number of youth offenders identified in violent crime increased 14% compared to average this quarter (and up 17% overall by the end of the year).
- There was a 12% increase above average of youth victims of violent crimes during the 4th Quarter with increases of robbery and assault youth victims.
- The total number of police service requests during the 4th Quarter was similar to the five-year average. Police attended an average of 952 calls a day. This is 3% below the 5-year average.
- Citizen use of the online reporting system was 23% higher than the 5-year average during the 4th Quarter, with 59 reports per day.
- Disorder calls accounted for an average of 214 calls per day from the public during the 4th Quarter of 2024. There was an average volume of disorder in the 4th Quarter and an 11% decline by the end of 2024. Most disorder call types noted a decline in 2024 with the exception of abandoned auto and disturbance calls which were notably above average by year-end.

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REPORT NOTES

Most of the statistical data in this report is derived from the Calgary Police Service records management system (SENTRY). Disorder data is derived from the Computer aided Dispatch (CAD) system. Data is compiled by the Corporate Data and Analytics Team of the Bureau of Service & Community Support.

Reporting is based on the most serious offence in the incident. Please note that offences are assigned to the month in which the offence was *reported*, which is not necessarily the month the offence occurred. The reported date is the first point in time at which the police were notified of the offence and reporting lag may vary due to circumstances (these are typically property crimes where the victim did not report the offence until a later date, or was unaware of the loss until a later date, or late-reported sexual assaults). Also note that "attempted" offences are included in these totals. Violent crime, excluding robbery, is counted by the number of victims, using the most serious offence against the victim. Robbery, and all other crime, is counted by incident using the most serious offence in the incident. Of note, cases are often cleared months and sometimes years later. Consequently, clearance rates for previous years may appear to be much higher than those of the present year. Cases "cleared by charge" and those "cleared otherwise" are included in these clearance rate totals.


