Introduction

The City of Calgary's updated Sustainable Building Policy was approved by City Council on April 29th, 2019. An important inclusion in the update was the addition of The Sustainable Building Guidance Document. This complimentary document includes requirements, specifications and building guidelines that provide those who help The City build with more detailed guidance and direction on City expectations and desired outcomes from a sustainability perspective.

The Sustainable Building Guidance Document is removed from the council policy itself so that it is more adaptable. It will continue to be updated and added to based on City needs, lessons learned and advancement within industry, standards and codes.

The current Sustainable Building Guidance Document is composed of six parts:

- Part A: Pre-project Sustainability Requirements Checklist
- Part B: Minimum Sustainability Performance Requirements
- Part C: Sustainable Building Policy Compliance Path Selection Tool
- Part D: Consultant Scopes of Work
- Part E: Recommended Certification Compliance Pathways (under development)
- Part F: Owner Project Requirements Template (under development)
