

### General Facts about the County

- The County is comprised of approximately 950,000
  acres of land
- Over 2,479 km of County roadways
- The County is over 105km from the NW corner to the SE corner and a shared border of over 115km with the City of Calgary, and 6 neighbouring partners within our borders
- Approximately 90% of land base is zoned for agriculture – large swathes of population and economic development located in an arc around Calgary & major highways – outer regions focused on agriculture while both residential and nonresidential development occur close to the City of Calgary to take advantage of agglomeration effects
- Home to over 44,500 residents who live in hamlets, acreages, and farms/ranches








### Fire Services 3 New Fire Stations






