•	Maintain the bees in such a condition as will reasonably prevent aggressive behavior indication of swarming, properly timed increases in the space available to the hive, sto ensure the queen has room to lay, and ensuring adequate ventilation in the hive. If made to collect the swarm. Contact a local beekeeping group if assistance is needed.	olitting the hive f a swarm is se	e, brood chamber manipulation			
•	Properly manage disease and pests.					
•	 Ensure a flight path does not become a nuisance for the neighbors. This can be done by directing hive entrances away from neighboring properties and putting fence or vegetative obstruction in front of the hive entrance to encourage bees to fly upward as soon as they leave the hive. 					
•	Keep no more than two hives on the property unless permission has been granted by	the City of Ca	algary.			
•	Water must be kept replenished and not allowed to run dry.					
•	Requeen a hive if it shows signs of being aggressive.					
•	 Minimize disturbance of the hive(s) and ensure hive(s) is not under stress. This can include using smoke to calm the bees, inspecting the hive(s) only when bees are out foraging and neighbours are not out in the yard; and ensuring the temperature of the hive is moderate and not in direct sunlight. 					
•	Keep the area around the hive clean to minimize likelihood of attracting other bees, wasps or unwanted visitors.					
•	If going away for an extended period of time, arrange for someone to inspect the hive(s).					
•	Take under advisement to keep liability insurance to cover incidents related to bees and beekeeping activities.
