Walk your home and view it from your pet's perspective: eliminate or move anything that looks tempting Develop a chore list for caring for the pet Plan how you will introduce any current pets Create a space in your home Establish your pet's routine Get a bed for your pet Learn the local animal bylaws ☐ Invest in a crate or carrier Purchase pet toys **Arrange these essential services** Plan for a play area **Veterinarian** Stock up on necessary supplies ☐ City of Calgary pet licence ☐ ID tags with your phone number, address and the pet's name **Certified professional dog-trainer** Baby-gate or ex-pen ☐ Pet food ☐ Water and food dishes **Pet insurance** Collar and/or harness Treats Leash Pet sitter Dog coats/boots ☐ Waste bags Litterbox and litter Groomer
