Personal Protective Equipment

These are boots with a hard toe.
What are steel-toe boots?

What are protective gloves?

If you get a blow to the top of the head, this item will reduce the impact.
What is a hard hat?

These are tight fitting eye protection.
What are safety glasses?

Construction Sites

All construction sites requiring fencing are required to post this.
What is contact information?

A tall piece of machinery that lifts construction materials from the ground.
What is a crane?

Found on the outside of a large towers, this equipment helps you get to hard to reach places.
What is Scaffolding?

This temporary wall is an important barrier to keep the public safe from the construction site
What is hoarding?

If you need to go to the bathroom, you will find one of these on a construction site.
What is a portable toilet?

Tools and Equipment

A great tool for nailing objects together like 2x4's.
What is a hammer?

This tool allows you to get up high enough to change a lightbulb.
What is a ladder?

Used for inserting and removing screws.
What is a screwdriver?

If you need to cut a piece of wood in half, this is a great tool.

This tool measures objects by width and length.
