




Dog Smart cards are divided into 6 categories: whole body, mouth, eyes, ears, tail, and quiz. There are 3 traffic light cards and 2 blue dog "joker" cards. Cards also have numbers for use in math related games.

Cards are color coded. Green = Go, means it's safe to means do not approach this dog. It is unsafe. Grey appoach this dog. Yellow = Caution, means slow down and let the dog come to you. Red = Stop, are self check cards and provide pairs.


