- 1. Which **TWO** things on the ambulance are **MOTORIZED** to assist us with lifting?
- 2. Did you notice which type of fuel we use in the ambulance? **GASOLINE** or **DIESEL**?
- 3. How many **SEATS** are in the back of the ambulance?
- 4. How many **SEATBELTS** are on our stretcher? (look carefully!)
- 5. Why is AMBULANCE printed **backward** on the hood of our units?
- 6. What do we use the **STAIR CHAIR** for?
- 7. **TRUE or FALSE?:** we carry a spare tire on the ambulance.
- 8. What do we use the **COMPUTER** in the cab for?
- 9. How many **EXTERIOR CABINETS** are there on the ambulance?
- 10. How many **SPARE BATTERIES** fit in the charger?
- 11. BONUS QUESTION: What COLOUR are our ORANGE spine boards?

ANSWER KEY:

- 1. The <u>oxygen lift system</u> and our <u>stretchers</u> are both motorized to assist us with lifting.
- 2. Our ambulances use gasoline; some ambulances use diesel, but ours use gasoline. You can see it printed on the side of the unit in the video.
- 3. There are <u>four seats</u> in the back of the ambulance. ALL of them have three-point harness seatbelts.
- 4. There are <u>FIVE sets</u> of seatbelts on our stretchers. Two are for the legs, one for the waist, and two others cross for the upper body.
- 5. The word AMBULANCE is printed backwards on the hood such that it can be read in the rearview mirror of a car it may be driving behind.
- 6. The stair-chair is equipment we use to <u>safely move a patient up or down</u> <u>stairs</u> without having to lift them.
- 7. TRUE. There is one spare tire aboard every ambulance.
- 8. We use the computer in the cab as a <u>mapping tool</u> to reach our destinations for emergency calls as well as <u>receive information</u> about our calls from our Dispatchers.
- 9. There are FIVE exterior cabinets in total on our ambulances.
- 10. Our charges can hold two spare batteries at a time. These are for the heart monitor.
