**We asked Calgarians if they were ready for an emergency.**

**We heard from 591 residents who identified as Racialized community members, this is what they told us.**

### What hazards are most likely to occur in Calgary in the next five years?



Extreme cold



Blizzards/severe winter storms



Hailstorms



Critical infrastructure failures/power outage



Extreme heat



Heavy rainfall

Report being affected by a community wide emergency or disaster in the last five years.

**73%**

**74%**

See climate change as a severe threat to Calgary in the next 20-30 years.

**40%**

**46%**

Feel able to look after their family without external supports in the immediate aftermath of an emergency or disaster.



### What stops you being more prepared for an emergency?

**35% | 29%**

Gave other reasons






