2 Your Senior Planning Technician can help guide you through the Development Permit application process and provide the list for what else you'll need to apply.

3 To submit an "Outdoor Patio/Café" Development Permit, you can apply online.

4 The Development Permit application will be reviewed by The City. The application will be circulated to internal and external stakeholders, a notice board will then be displayed on the property and is advertised. After a 21-day appeal period, the permit is released.

Note: Applicant and general public have an opportunity to appeal the Development Permit decision online (Subdivision Development Appeal board).

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3 To submit an "Outdoor Patio/Café" Development Permit, you can apply online.

4 The Development Permit application will be reviewed by The City. The application will be circulated to internal and external stakeholders, a notice board will then be displayed on the property and is advertised. After a 21-day appeal period, the permit is released. *If your outdoor patio/café is partially on a city sidewalk, road or laneway, you will be provided with contact from the Roads department to determine if they will support the application.
