FEBRUARY 2022 DEVELOPING THEMES

Information, ideas, quotes, and stories from engagement events were all used to develop overarching themes emerging from the data. Community leaders, Elders, knowledge keepers, subject matter experts, and the Anti-Racism Action Committee (ARAC) came together over 3 meetings to review the information gathered during engagement events and they helped to sort and prioritize the feedback based on community feedback and suggestions.

The first meeting of participants from the Tier 2 phase is completed, with the next meeting to be hosted in February. The community engagement team continues to work alongside Elders and Knowledge Keepers to guide this process. The project team began developing the structure of the final report. The team worked alongside Elders, Knowledge Keepers, and The City's Anti-Racism team to shape the key messages that will be included in the report. The final report is due to be released this fall to the public.

MARCH 2022 DEVELOPING ACTIONS

The Community leaders, Elders, knowledge keepers, subject matter experts, and the Anti-Racism Action Committee completed their meetings in early March. This group helped to uncover, strengthen and create tangible actions from the information gathered

The project team began developing the structure of the final report and worked alongside Elders, Knowledge Keepers, and The City Anti-Racism team to shape the key messaging to be included within the report.

APRIL - MAY 2022 REPORT WRITING
