The Capacity-Building and Emerging Issues Fund is available to eligible non-profit organizations for one-time initiatives to strengthen their organizational effectiveness, increase their programs' impact, and address emerging issues and trends that are impacting Calgarians. The Capacity-Building and Emerging Issue Fund is implemented via two focus areas:

Emerging Social Issues: Funds are available to support one-time initiatives that address emerging issues and trends that are impacting Calgarians experiencing vulnerabilities.

Organizational Effectiveness: Funds are available to support one-time initiatives that increase an organization's effectiveness in supporting Calgarians experiencing vulnerabilities.

Eligible projects must be one-time initiatives that can be completed by December 31, 2023.
