Directions to Haskayne Legacy Park

There is **only one vehicle route** into the park:

Tuscany and Rocky Ridge Continue towards Rocky View County

• Drive west on Crowchild Trail NW (Highway 1A) past


• Turn south onto **Woodland Road** (Range Road 31)

• Follow Woodland Road around several curves and turns until you reach the parking lots

Woodland Rd is a new road, so the **Google navigation** route is incorrect.




GRASSLAND AREA
