Enmax Legacy Parks Program 3 — Haskayne Regional Park



Haskayne Regional Park Concept

Project: This 186 hectare land assembly for a new regional park abuts Glenbow Ranch Provincial Park and is located on the north bank of the Bearspaw Reservoir. The site is a combination of two land purchases as well as an ecological gift. The park design is underway. This site has received an additional Haskayne family donation to assist in site development. This park will be a central waterfront and regional park hub in the Calgary to Cochrane pathway system.

Budget: \$8.8M estimated development budget from Legacy phase 3.

Timeline: Resolution of the access issue is underway as is the design development

process. The South Bearspaw Area Structure Plan (ASP) has also been initiated.

Status: Ongoing discussions with land owners, Glenbow Provincial Park and others oc-

cur around site coordination and access.

Benefits: This new regional park will provide Calgarians with waterfront access to the Bearspaw Reservoir, as well as a park celebrating Calgary's heritage, ecology and art, located adjacent the Glenbow Ranch Provincial Park.
