Paskapoo Slopes

Project: In 1994, the *Urban Parks Master Plan* identified the naturally forested river valley stands of the Paskapoo Slopes as a future desired park. The development of a Concept for the park and Environmental Reserve (ER) lands has been drafted. This area has increasing uncontrolled access and use of the slopes which will detrimentally affect the environment.

Budget: Estimated initial phase of \$2.93M on current City lands.

Timeline: To be determined.

Phased plan should address adjacent landowner interface.

Status: Design Development Plan draft completed, based on currently held City lands.

Benefits: A virtual extension of the Douglas Fir slopes, this dramatic landscape is an exceptional remnant landscape in Calgary and was identified for conservation more than 15 years ago.
