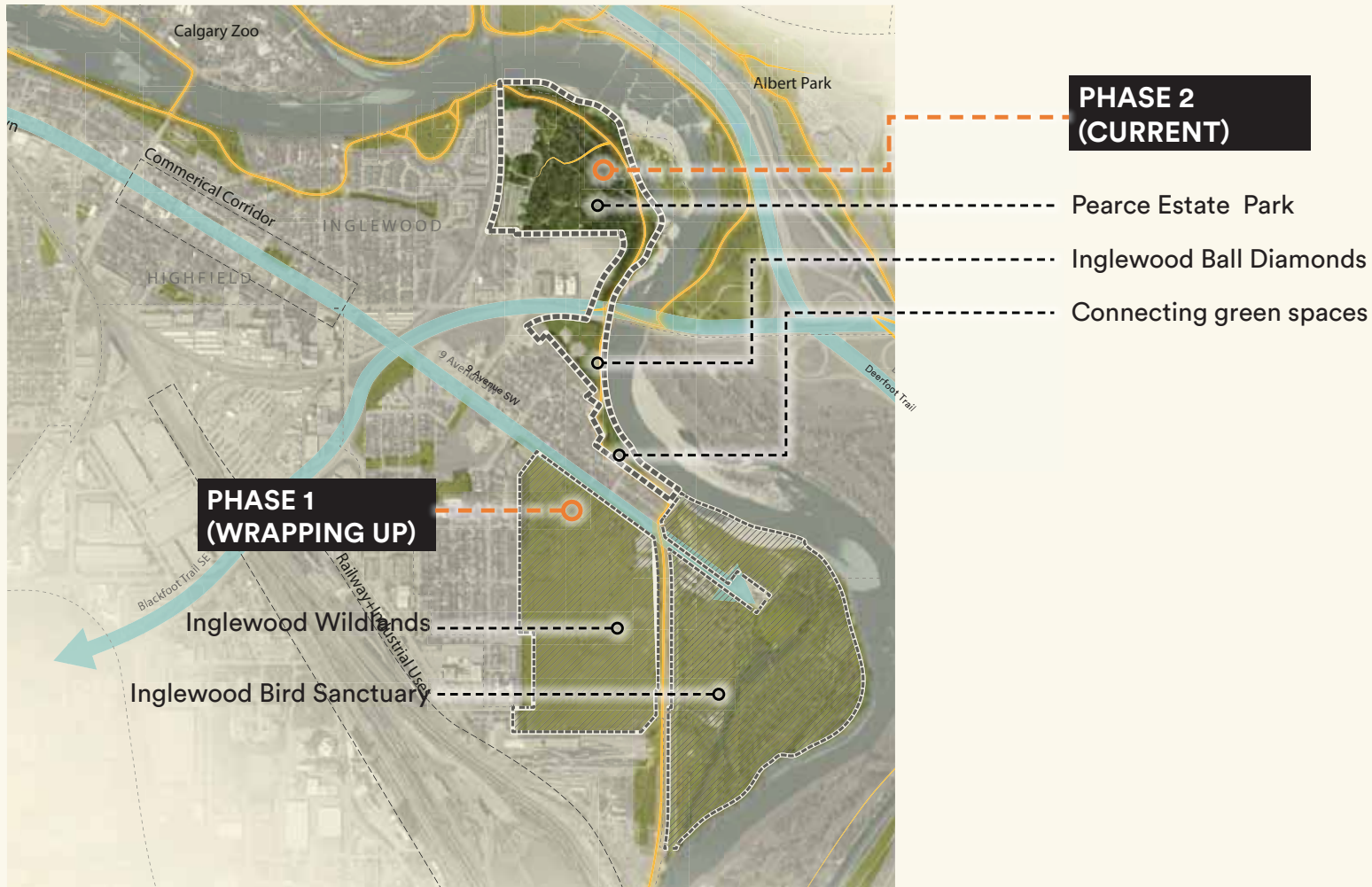

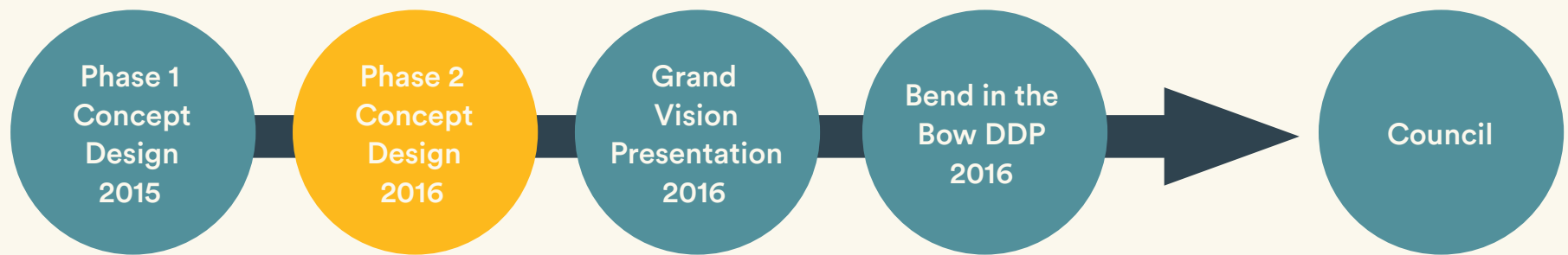

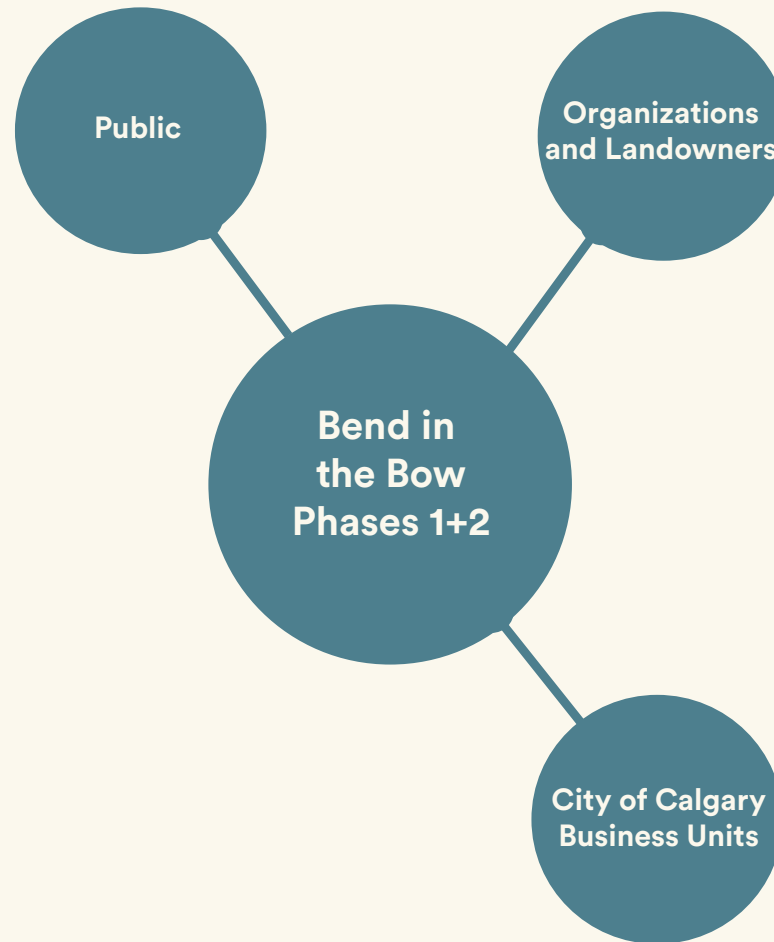

Culture

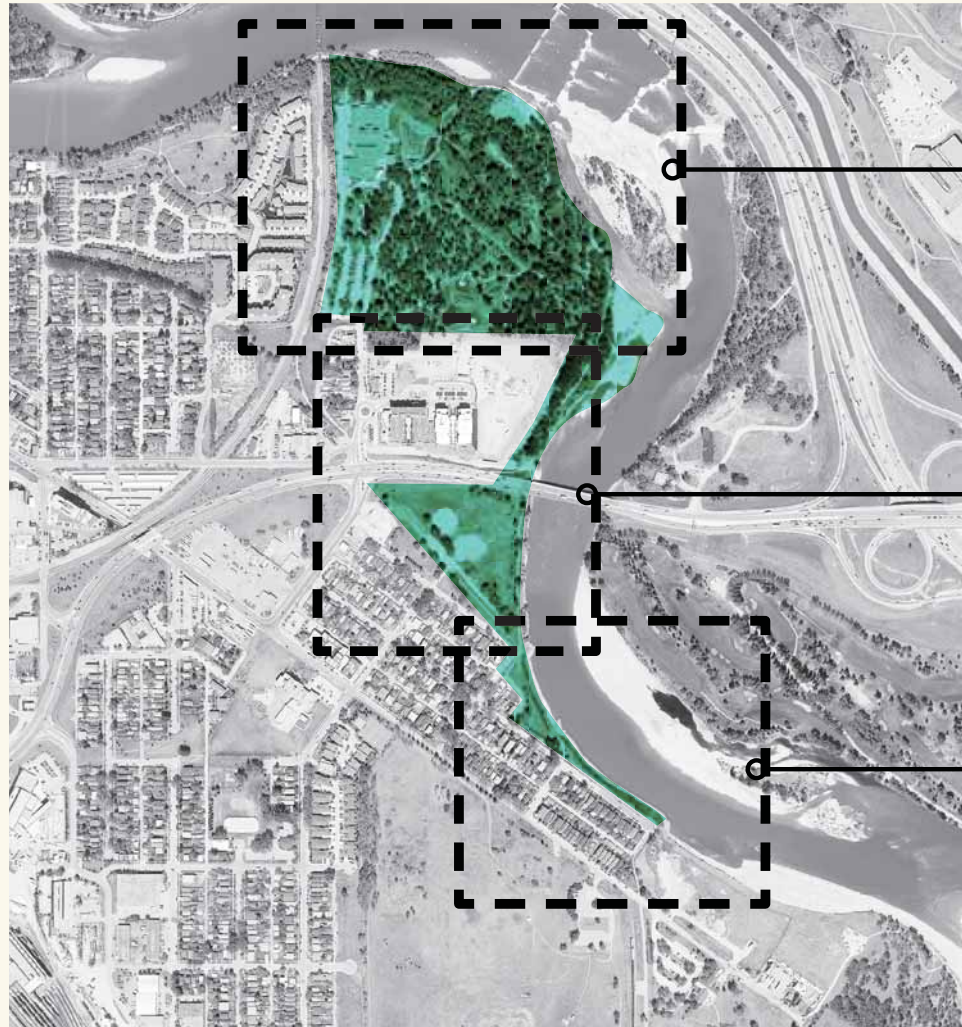
- We will conserve and celebrate the site's historic significance, and recognize the valuable contributions of its former residents.

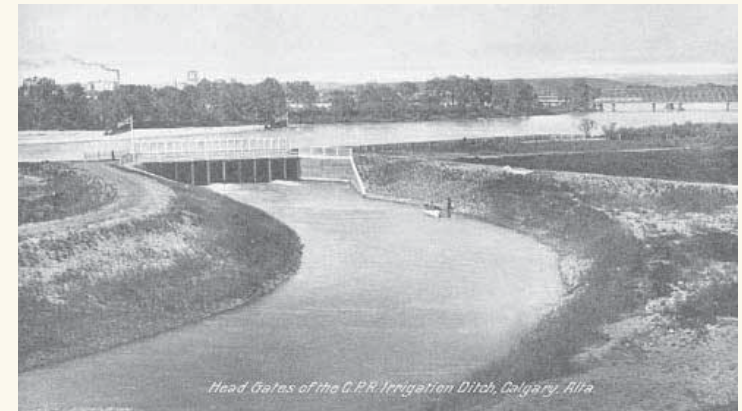
